To those that we hold dear that have been so faithful in lifting us up in prayer. These past months have been so strange – we have been so busy with visiting, ministering, and praying more for those with cancer, high blood pressure, diabetes, anxiety, suicidal attempts, memory loss, serious problems with internal organs, alcohol abuse, etc. Not sure if it has anything to do with the side effects from the Covid-19 vaccine; but one thing is for sure we have noticed greater spectrum of prayer requests. Below we have listed a few prayers requests and praise reports:

Prayer requests:

- For our continual safety as we travel. We have made numerous trips to Chihuahua for one reason or another and Daniel continues to travels back and forth on the weekends from the university.
- For a brother in the church, Emeterio (44 years old) who fell back into drinking after one year of being sober. His mother and Mark drove 4 hours one way to put him in an alcohol rehab center.
- For a sister in the church, Yolanda, (66 years old) was just put on a dialysis machine.
- For Nicole (2 years old-first photo-before surgery) has a cancerous tumor behind her right eye and is being schedule to have her eye remove. (Because of unexpected circumstances we were not able to send this letter in time and her eye has been removed.) Next week they will start chemotherapy and the doctors are hoping that the other eye has not been affected. Please pray for her quick recovery, that her left eye will not be affected, and for continued strength for her mom Claudia.
- A brother from our church just found at that his 58 year old sister has cancer in the uterus.
- A 50 year old friend from San Juanito tried to commit suicide- her mother just walked in at the right moment – a moment that was divinely intervened by God Almighty! Thank you precious Jesus for guiding her mom to visit her daughter at the right moment!
- For prayer against spirits of anxiety, depression, diabetes, memory lost, alcoholic addiction, etc.
- For the family of two drug lords (who are brothers). That we have been visiting lately and they have been so grateful for our visits and prayers. (Note: We do not make it known to them that we are aware of their son's activities.)
- For all those involved in the drug wars, that they will come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- For healing to come to the families whom have lost loved ones by the hands of the drug lords.
- For young men such as Moises (17 years old) Javier (32) Angel (35) that have been kidnapped by the drug lords to work for them.
- For Omar, Luis, Ramon, Amelia, Teodoro, Oscar, Anselmo, Manuela, that have fallen away from their faith in God. That they will repent with a broken heart and realize how much Jesus loves them!
- For our Christmas activities: The 5th – 16th of December we will be giving over 2500 gift packages to children at 28 schools. A few of the schools are in San Juanito, but the majority are in outlying locations where we will be driving anywhere from 30 minutes to over two hours one way on very rough roads.



Praise Reports:

- We give thanks to God for allowing us to complete 30 years of marriage in October. God has taken us through some difficult and challenging times and we are so grateful to Him for giving us the endurance and strength to press on with Him, the ministry, and for each other!
- We give thanks to God Almighty that has been so good to see us through the Covid-19 phase – and we can only believe that he will continue to allow us to walk in good health and to continue the work that he has so graciously entrusted to us.
- Crystal and Cassandra are in their 11th of 14 semesters of their career of becoming doctors. Then depending on what they specialize in they will then have an additional 3-4 more years. Daniel is in his 7th of 10 semesters of his career of becoming a Registered Nurse.
- Every Saturday we continue to be in the middle of the town doing projects with the children and visiting with those that come by our booth. (Similar to a flea market.) We are so thankful to God for those that we have been able to make contact with.
- Our assistance Pastor Armando is on different medication for his Parkinson and we have seen such great improvement!
- Thank you all that have given financially or sent stuffed animals to help reach our goal of 2500 for the Christmas outreach.
